



APCC Bridge (Virtual) Summer Camp 2022

Let's make friends around the world

Due to the restrictions currently in place around the world – APCC is again going virtual this year so that children who would have been eligible to apply for APCC in Fukuoka this year have the opportunity to participate in a specially designed program sharing both with Japanese children as well as children from the Asia Pacific region and wider including Peru, Bordeaux and maybe even Kyrgyzstan. The program will be run over 5 sessions with 3 sessions being shared with children all over the world.

Australian Japan Society of Victoria is looking for four children (two boys and two girls) to be part of this program which will occur between July and August via zoom. We are looking for children who are inquisitive about the world, eager to share their thoughts and ideas with others and make friend with children from different countries.

To participate as a junior ambassador, participants must be born between August 1st, 2010 and July 31st 2011 and be available to participate in the whole program. Given that this program is mainly online, we encourage applications from rural children given the limited number of visits to Melbourne required. The proposed dates including interview dates are included in the information package. Please note, children must be available for all the dates (interview, pre-meeting via zoom, three sessions (Sunday mornings) and a post activity get together in person in Melbourne)!

The selection process to choose the four children will consist of an interview with two or three members of Bridge Club Australia/Australia Japan Society of Victoria as per the dates in the information package.
